Proposed by Thomas Moore and seconded
by J. S. Cleator that all accounts standing
against the original Committee for
passing the Bill be called in for
examination,

Proposed by R. Seare and seconded
by J. S. Cleator that the Town be
fully inspected by the Commissioners to
find out those places which require their
attention,

Resolved that Messrs Seare, Looney and
Cleator, be appointed a deputation to
wait upon the Douglas Town Commissioners

Resolved that Enquiries be made
respecting Lamp Posts and Brackets for
lighting the Town with Gas,
