



A18 Mountain Road Temporary Closure

The Department of Infrastructure gives notice that under section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985, it will prohibit vehicular and pedestrian traffic from proceeding on that section of the A18 Mountain Road between the Ramsey Hairpin and the Creg Ny Baa Back Road, Onchan.

This Notice will be in force from 7.00am on **10 April 2018** until 10.00pm on **12 April 2018** or until the patching, lining and pre TT signage work is completed, whichever is the earlier.

In the event of adverse weather conditions during the above dates, the closure may be postponed to 7.00am on **17 April 2018** until 10.00pm on **19 April 2018** or until the patching, lining and pre TT signage work is completed, whichever is the earlier.

Access to properties will be maintained. Access will also be allowed for emergency vehicles and personnel, public works vehicles, and others with the permission of the Department.

An alternative route will be via the A2 Ramsey to Douglas Coast Road.
