Information Requested:

"Please provide copies of all correspondence between Ramsey Town Commissioners (members and officers) and the individuals behind Ramsey Marina Limited or anyone representing these individuals (before or after the company was formed) on the subject of Ramsey Marina, Ramsey Harbour, Ramsey Bay, South Beach and the Queen's Pier; all details of any meetings held between the same, including when, where and who was present at such meetings, along with the purpose of the meeting and any notes/minutes taken."

You provided confirmation that you were seeking information prior to 11<sup>th</sup> March 2019.

Our responses to your requests are as follows:

### Meetings

Two Meetings took place with regards to the Ramsey Marina Proposals.

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The first took place at 7pm on 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2018, at the home of Robin Bromley-Martin, attended by Mr T P Whiteway (Town Clerk) and Mr A G Cowie (Chairman).

The meeting had been requested by way of an introduction on the subject of the IOM Harbours Strategy, and comprised disclosure of the principle of a Ramsey Marina proposal and a request to make a formal presentation to the Commissioners.

The second meeting was a formal presentation to Ramsey Town Commissioners on 28<sup>th</sup> March 2018, the minutes of this meeting were recorded in private as being commercially sensitive, which have subsequently been brought into the public domain and are available on our website.

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In response to an application for review, the Information Commissioner may, at any time, attempt to resolve a matter by negotiation, conciliation, mediation or another form of alternative dispute resolution and will have regard to any outcome of this in making any subsequent decision.
