

Statutory Notice: RCO 432

Various Roads, Ramsey (Public Events) Notice 2020

The Department of Infrastructure gives notice of the following road traffic restrictions authorised under Section 38 of the Highways Act 1986.

1 Roads closed to vehicular traffic

The roads specified in Schedule 1 will be closed to vehicular traffic during the period specified in column 2 of that Schedule.

2 Prohibition of parking

Parking will be prohibited on the roads specified in Schedule 2 during the period specified in column 2 of that Schedule.

3 Exemptions

Paragraphs 1 and 2 shall not apply to emergency service vehicles, public works vehicles and vehicles approved by the organiser (Ramsey Town Commissioners).
